Trainer's Course For Qualified Montessori Diploma Holders.

This course has been designed to prepare Montessori trainers of the Montessori Method of Education using the ICME course materials and the ICME classroom syllabus books for children.

The course is certified by ICME and the Jordanian Ministry of Education. (Annex 10 and 11).

AIMS

This course aims to prepare, familiarise, revise and review with the participants

- ICME course materials.
- Montessori theory of education. Developmental psychology.
- Presentation of Montessori apparatus in all areas:
 - ***** Exercises of practical life activities.
 - **❖** Sensorial.
 - Mathematics.
 - **!** Literacy and language.
 - Cultural and environmental studies.
 - Creative arts.
- The knowledge and skills for delivering lectures to students in all areas of the Montessori curriculum for children aged 3 to 6 years.
- Knowledge and skills for using the ICME syllabus books for children.
- Knowledge and skills for tutoring students and evaluating course work and teaching practice.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

On completion of this course participants will:

- Have a knowledge of the ICME course materials.
- Be aware of the current educational thought and research in developmental psychology and be able critically to reflect upon the Montessori theory of education in the light of this new knowledge.
- Be aware of the psychology behind each area in the curriculum, be able to prepare and present a full session in at least one area of the curriculum to the group and will have confidence in presentation skills.
- Be aware of different teaching strategies and learning styles of adults and children

• Be able to set up a Montessori classroom and prepare a Montessori curriculum using the ICME syllabus books.

- Trainers must hold the equivalent of the Montessori international diploma.
- Trainers must have at least three years experience working with children in the classroom.
